Our annual **Novena to Our Lady of Perpetual Succour** continues this Tuesday evening, 16 June, at 7.00pm – or whenever works for you. This week we consider *The Burial of Jesus*. Although at home we can still pray together. Pray it when you can.

There is a **National Weekly Mass**, celebrated by a bishop in his cathedral, taking place **each Thursday evening at 7.00pm** for the sick in hospital, their families and the front-line health care workers as a focus of our Catholic community support. Archbishop Longley is to celebrate, **this Thursday, 18 June**, from Birmingham cathedral. The Mass can be followed on Livestream.

St Joseph's school has been open throughout the lockdown for children of keyworkers. **Please be aware**, if you are visiting the cemetery (also open throughout lockdown), that from this Monday, 15 June, there will be a short period from 8:50am in the morning and 2:55pm in the afternoon when Year 6 pupils will be entering and leaving the school via the cemetery gate. As social-distancing rules still apply, it would be good to avoid any traffic jams! This will only be Mon/Tues and Thurs/Fri.

Both the **Schools Pilgrimage** and the **Diocesan Pilgrimage to Padley**, this year on the anniversary of the martyrs' arrest on 12 July, **have had to be cancelled this year**
