The Mass of the Supper of the Lord

Maundy Thursday, 1 April, will be at 7.00pm – Fully booked

Please note; only one such celebration is permitted on this night and there will be no Washing of Feet, Procession to the Altar of Repose or 'Watching' at the end of holy Mass.

The Celebration of the Lord's Passion Good Friday, 2 April, will be at 12 Noon, 3.00pm & 4.30pm

All the services will be the same and all will include the Passion, a communal veneration of the Cross and the reception of Holy Communion.

The Masses of the Resurrection of the Lord Holy Saturday, 3 April, will be at 5.00pm & 6.30pm & Easter Sunday, 4 April, at 9.00am & 10.00am

The Renewal of Baptismal Promises will take place at all Masses. The Vigil ceremonies are significantly curtailed, e.g. the Easter fire is to be omitted and the vigil readings will be truncated.

- There will be a handful of places set aside on Good Friday and Easter morning for those who turn up on the day but these should not be relied upon. Once the church is full you can only follow from outside; you can receive Holy Communion as usual.
