

During Lent:

- On **Sundays**, after the 10.00am Mass, there will be **Stations of the Cross**. *Please sign-up to lead the Stations*.

- On Mondays in Lent there will be Mass at 7.15am.

- On **Tuesdays in Lent** there will be **Stations of the Cross & Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament,** from 7.00 to 7.45pm (concluding with Benediction). Confessions will also be available (*N.B.* except on 29 March). *Please sign-up to lead the Stations.*

Next **Saturday, 19 March**, we will have **Mass at 10.00am** to celebrate the **Feast of St Joseph**, to offer thanksgiving and to pray for the needs of the parish.

First Holy Communion Preparation: we next meet on Saturday, 26 March, in St Joseph's school. The class will be from 09.30am to 12.00 noon. Attendance at all classes is essential.

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation will take place at St Joseph's from 9.15 to 10.00am on the following Saturday mornings: **26 March**, 23 April and 7 & 21 May. Bishop Heskett will celebrate the Mass of Confirmation at St Joseph's on Saturday, 11 June, 2022 at 5.00pm.

Offertory envelopes for the new tax year, commencing in April, are **available to collect** from this weekend in the church. To save on costs, envelopes are no longer available for those parishioners who have moved to donating by bank transfer or standing order unless they request it, but they are still included in the Gift Aid scheme if they have previously completed a Gift Aid declaration. Anyone who last year had a numbered envelope higher than 80 will find that they have a new number this year and, if they had previously completed a Gift Aid declaration, this will continue automatically. If anyone pays UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax and has not completed a Gift Aid declaration, but would like to know more about the scheme, then they can speak to Tony Brodrick or Fr M. Thank you for your continuing support.
