

Some changes at the church of St Charles Borromeo

As was recently announced, the Sheffield Polish Catholic Community have now moved to their new premises on Broomspring Lane, near the University of Sheffield. This means that they have concluded their use of St Charles Church which they had care of during the pandemic. All our parishes have been affected by the pandemic and the current community living in St Charles parish has been no exception. For the past three years the small resident Catholic community has had its various sacramental, pastoral and educational needs served from St Joseph's church and school at Handsworth and this will continue to be the case.

However, in order to cater to the needs of the now larger Slovak Catholic Community that principally resides in the area (and the wider city and neighbouring Rotherham for example) the care of St Charles Church will be passed to them. Other groups such as Jesus Youth and the Eritrean Orthodox Community also make their 'home' there. In a time of great change it is important to evaluate things and this provision will be reviewed again by the bishop at a future date.

In many ways this means that much remains the same and both the patrimony of the church of St Charles and the spiritual needs of her people, whichever language group they belong to, shall, please God, continue to be cared for.

The feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on 11 February is also the occasion of the annual World Day of Prayer for the Sick. This is an observation that was introduced by Pope St John Paul II as a way for believers to offer their prayers for those suffering from illnesses. As this falls on a Saturday this year I will offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at the conclusion of the 5.00pm Mass and also at the 12 February, Sunday morning Masses too.
