

There is a **retiring collection this weekend for the Bishops' Conference Day for Life**. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. The focus this year is *'Listen to Her'* and focuses on post-abortion trauma and the impact of abortion primarily on women, but also men and others.

Each year a message is released, usually by a bishop, offering a reflection on the year's theme. The 2023 message is unique in that the bishops' have given it over to a Catholic woman who has had an abortion to share her experiences. Next **Thursday, 29 June**, we observe the **Solemnity of St Peter & St Paul, a Holyday of Obligation**. Our Masses are at 10.00am - with St Joseph's School - and 7.00pm on the day.
