

Wednesday, 1 November, The Solemnity of All Saints, is a *Holyday of Obligation*. There is a Vigil Mass on Tuesday 31 October at 7.00pm and a 10.00am Mass, with our school, at St Joseph's on Wednesday, 1 November.

Thursday, 2 November, All Souls Day, 10.00am Mass at St Joseph's followed by Prayers for the Dead & the Blessing of Graves in the cemetery.

Schools' admissions & baptism certificates (or certificates of Reception into Full Communion with the Catholic Church): If you require a certificate in order to complete your child's admission form then please email your request with the name and date of birth of your child and it will be attended to. If you can remember an approximate date for when the Baptism/ Reception took place then that is even more helpful. N.B. Applications to Catholic Schools by those in the admissions category above do NOT require a letter of support from a priest – the certificate is all that is required.

#### November Memorial Dead List 2023 – 2024

The celebration of holy Mass is the simplest yet also the greatest means by which the Church on earth provides care and assistance for the dead – though we can also assist them in their 'journey' through the purification of purgatory by means of our prayers, offered sufferings and penances, especially when they have indulgences attached to them. Beginning in November we offer Masses for the Parish November Memorial Dead List throughout the year.
