- Confessions: on the Monday and Tuesday, 25 & 26 March, at 3.15pm to 4.15pm there will be two sessions of after-school Confessions. N.B. The final public Confessions before Easter will be on Tuesday evening, 26 March, at 6.00 to 7.00pm (or until finished if later).
- On Wednesday, **27 March**, at 11.00am Bishop Heskett will celebrate the **Mass of Chrism** at the cathedral.
- On, **27 March**, the Wednesday of Holy Week, **St Joseph's School** will perform their **Passion Play** in the church at 2.00pm. All welcome.
- Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper, The Washing of Feet: There is a sign-up list at the back of church for those who are willing to have a foot washed during this celebration. More people are still needed.
- Good Friday is a day of Fasting & Abstinence; everyone aged 14 years and older should abstain from consuming meat, while everyone aged from 18 to 59 should fast, unless exempt (usually for a medical reason). Regardless of age everyone is encouraged to observe the spirit of the day and to assume some form of penance.
