The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on Wednesday, 11 February, is also the occasion of the annual World Day of Prayer for the Sick. This is an observation that was introduced by Pope St John Paul II as a way for believers to offer their prayers for those suffering from illnesses. As we established a few of years ago, this means that I will offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick **at the conclusion of the 5.00pm Mass on Saturday, 7 February, and at the end of the Sunday morning Masses, 8 February.**

Ash Wednesday, 18 February, a Day of Fasting & Abstinence: our annual observance of Lent begins with Masses at 10.00am and 7.00pm.

Thursday, 19 March, the Solemnity of St Joseph and our patronal feast day. Mass at 10.00am with St Joseph's School.

Palm Sunday, 29 March, Holy Week begins.

Easter Sunday, 5 April, The Resurrection of the Lord.
